Hiring for Assessment Director for the RISE Program

Description: The Provost's office invites T&R faculty to apply for the position of Assessment Director to lead RISE program assessment. The Assessment Director should have the skills to collect and analyze large data sets, be able to implement and improve upon an existing data plan, and have a passion for student equity and success.

Expectations:

- Work with Institutional Research (IR) and the Office of Institutional Effectiveness and Quality Improvement (IEQI) to ensure timely collection of RISE data.
- Produce reports for RISE program based on data collected and analysis. Examples include equity data reports for RISE Community Action Teams, reports for Department Chairs, Deans, and Provost.
- Create and implement data collection plans that support the program. Examples include collection and analysis of student sense of belonging surveys, student outcomes in 100 and 200 level courses, and faculty institute outcomes.
- Thoughtful analysis of data to help inform the direction of the program.
- Consistent effective collaboration with the RISE leadership team.
- Presentation of data to campus partners as needed with a keen focus on closing equity gaps in student success.

Contribute to yearly progress report to document progress.

Compensation: Recognizing the importance of this work as well as the large time commitment required, this position includes a two-course/semester (6 contact hours) reassignment and a summer stipend. This position will report to the Director of Institutional Effectiveness and Quality Improvement.

Application submission: Please indicate your interest by emailing your current CV and a letter of interest to <u>rise@radford.edu</u> by **Friday, February 16.** The RISE Leadership Team, in conjunction with Dr. Jessica Stowell, Director of Institutional Effectiveness and Quality Improvement, will review applications and conduct interviews with candidates. The current RISE Assessment Director retires May 24, so this position will start in earnest this summer, with expectation of some overlapping time this semester to learn from our current director.

About RISE: The Realizing Inclusive Student Excellence (RISE) Quality Enhancement Plan is underway in its first year of programming. RISE aims to improve student success and close racial equity gaps in required 100 and 200 level courses as well as increase student's academic and campus belonging. We are reaching these goals through two programmatic pieces: (1) The RISE Faculty Institute and (2) RISE Community Action Teams (RCATs) in each college. The QEP is housed in the Office of Institutional Effectiveness and Quality Improvement (IEQI) and has tripartite leadership including a Program Director, Faculty Institute Director, and an Assessment Director. The RISE leadership team closely collaborates with campus partners including Institutional Research, Student Affairs, and the Center for Innovative Teaching and Learning.
