SENIOR CITIZEN TUITION WAIVER CERTIFICATION

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

I certify that I meet all the requirements of the Senior Citizens Higher Education Act of 1974 which allows Senior Citizens of the Commonwealth of Virginia to take courses at state colleges free of charge.

The Act states that to be eligible, persons must have reached 60 years of age before the beginning of the semester in which they wish to enroll and must have had legal domicile in Virginia for at least one year prior to the semester in which they plan to enroll.

Senior Citizens who meet the requirements are entitled:

- (1) To register for and enroll in courses as full-time or part-time students for academic credit.
- (2) To register for and audit courses offered for academic credit.
- (3) To register for and enroll in noncredit courses.

The Act provides that courses taken for credit are free if a senior citizen has a taxable income of less than \$23,850. Audit courses may be taken without charge regardless of income.
